What Is the Church Integration Inventory?

The Church Integration Inventory moves churches beyond surface-level faith-and-work conversations and helps leaders understand both the visible structures and invisible cultural dynamics that shape ministry effectiveness.

It is a research-based organizational assessment grounded in organizational research and organizational change and biblical principles. It identifies beliefs, behaviors, and systems that may be working against the church's mission, and reveals the shifts needed for deeper integration and greater Kingdom impact.

What You'll Discover

Rather than measuring attendance or program success, the inventory examines the underlying culture, leadership, systems, and congregational engagement that shape how people live out their faith Monday through Saturday.

Leadership

The alignment, understanding, and commitment among leaders to equip their congregation in their everyday work.

Church Culture

How effective church culture supports faith-work integration and the biblical value and purpose of everyday work.

Congregation

How your people understand their vocational calling and influence, engage with their work, and connect faith with everyday life.

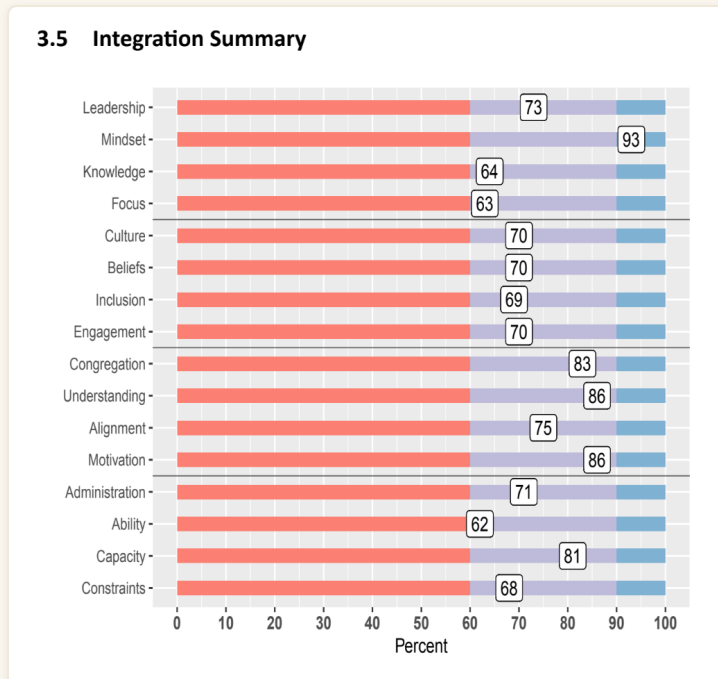
Administration

A customized and detailed report across the four key areas, twelve key indicators and twelve key ideas act as a dashboard for church leadership.

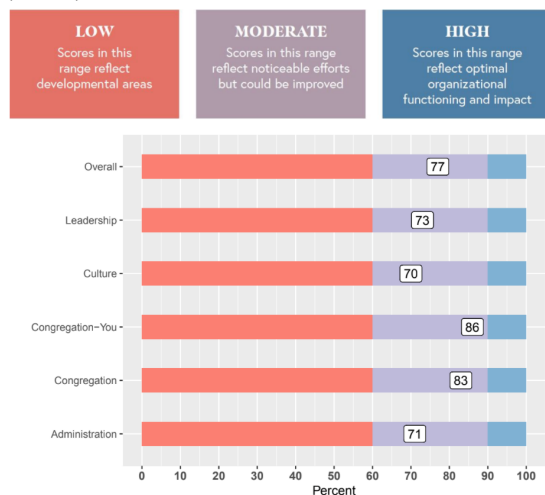

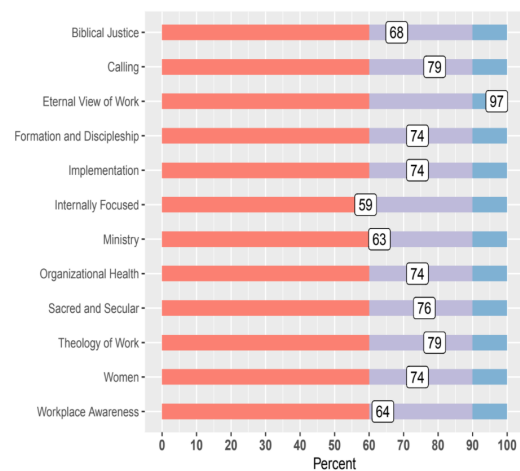
